Nogales – Mariposa Alternative 1



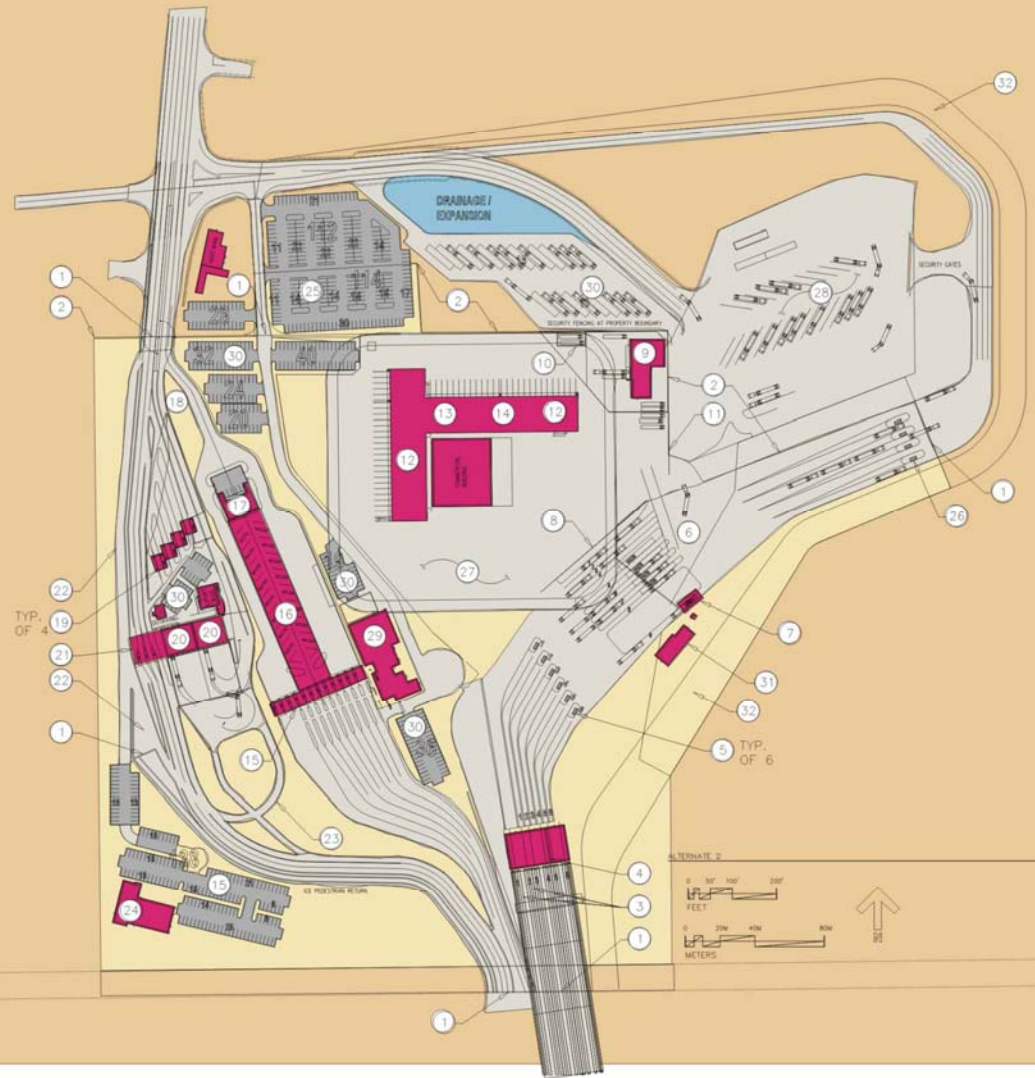
